Prayer of Great Thanksgiving (Responsive)

L: May God be with us. **P: God is here among us.**

- L: Let us open our hearts to God.
- P: We open them to God and to one another.
- L: Let us give thanks to God.
- P: It is right to give thanks and praise.
- L: Creator of light, Giver of all life... to proclaim the glory of your name:
- P: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.
- L: Let us remember together that vision of God's reign shown to us in Jesus at table:

P: he shared food with followers and friends,
