Water is poured into the font.

L: Blessed are you, O God, Ruler of the universe, Maker of heaven and earth, Keeper of sky and sea. At the beginning, your Spirit was at work, brooding over the waters of creation's birth. Again and again you have shown your grace to us through water: cleansing the earth at the flood, parting for the exodus at the Red Sea, flowing from the rock in the wilderness.

P: Blessed are you, O God.

L: In Jesus you promised that all who thirst could come to the living water. He who was baptized in the water of repentance becomes for us the never-failing spring, welling up to eternal life. As he suffered for us, the piercing of his side brought forth blood and water, sign of the death we all die in him so that we may also rise with him.

P: Blessed are you, O God.
