Invitation to the Table***Prayer of Great Thanksgiving (Responsive)***

L: The Holy One is here.

P: God's Spirit is with us.

L: Lift up your hearts.

P: We lift them to the Lord.

L: Let us give thanks to God.

P: It is right to offer thanks and praise.

L: Holy God of wind and fire, your Spirit renews the face of the earth and warms the hearts of your people. We give you thanks for your gifts of Pentecostal power: tongues that utter prophetic words of truth and justice; flames that kindle new visions of compassion and peace; fresh breezes that blow down the walls which separate us from you and one another. And so, it is that we join with every voice and tongue on earth and in the heavens to give you praise:

**P: Holy, holy, holy,
Lord God of Hosts!
Heaven and earth are full of your glory!
Heaven and earth praise you,
O God most high!**

L: As we gather at this table, we remember that on the night before he died, Jesus had supper with his friends. He took a loaf of bread, thanked you as we have thanked you, broke the bread, and gave it to them, saying: "Take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Each time you do this, remember me." Then, he took a cup, and after giving thanks, passed it to his friends, saying: "Drink. This cup is the promise of God, made in my blood. Each time you drink from this cup, remember me." Loving God, we rejoice in the gift of your grace, remembering Christ's life and death, proclaiming his resurrection, waiting in hope for his coming again. Grant that in praise and thanksgiving, we may so offer ourselves to you that our lives may proclaim the mystery of faith:

**P: We remember his death,
we proclaim his resurrection,
we await his coming in glory.**

L: Send your Holy Spirit upon us and upon this offering of your church, that we who eat and drink at Christ's table may share in his life.

Pour out your Spirit upon the whole earth,
and make it your new creation.

Gather your church together from the ends of the earth into your realm where peace and justice are revealed—

that we, with all your people, of every language, race, and nation,
may share the banquet you have promised.

We praise you, eternal God, through Christ your Word made flesh, and in the power of your life-giving Spirit, now and forever. These and all our prayers we gather into the prayer Jesus taught...
